## **VIEW FROM THE CHAIR Barb Rudolph March 2025**

Usually we celebrate "giving thanks" in November but this year, we declare March as the official "BAC Give Thanks to New Ride Leaders" month. In 2024, 10 people who had never been a part of a BAC leadership team took the plunge. Thank you for your time, your hard work, your kindness and creativity. Thank you for helping to lead your friends on some amazing BAC tours.

**Gordon Jones** co-directed his first BAC tour with experienced ride leader, **Joan Bricker**. Together they took riders into the Canadian Rockies for a two-week adventure with majestic views, abundant wildlife and spectacular hikes. **Fred Hughes** also earned his stripes on this tour as a first-time driver.

Meanwhile on the other side of the continent, **Tim Presar**, also a first-time driver, got behind the wheel for **Albert Balingit and Jacqui Duerr's** tour in and around Cape Cod taking in the pristine beaches, captivating history, and old-fashioned charm.

Just a short time later, **Robert Becker**, first-time co-director for the Appalachian Blue Ridge tour with **Julie Leever**, learned how to manage a BAC tour in a weather disaster as Hurricane Helene barreled into North Carolina. After just 2 days of riding, Robert and Julie successfully rescued everyone, secured them safely in a hotel (without power or water!) and shuttled them and their bikes out of the flooded area.

Overseas, **James Brennerman** and **Susi Vogler**, first-time drivers, tackled the European roads with **Randy and Lucy Glover.** James was a first-time driver from the Julian Alps, through the Triglav National Park and on to the Adriatic coast on the Slovenia's Heart tour. Susi was a first-time driver on the Eastern Swiss Lakes tour that took riders through Switzerland, Germany, Austria and Liechtenstein.

**Pamela Kelly**, an experienced bicycle tour leader outside of the BAC, coordinated her first two BAC tours in Turkey (BikeHike Turkey-Aegean Coast from Istanbul to Cappadocia) and Bhutan (Bhutan - The Last Buddhist Kingdom). Riders explored the rich history and unique geography of Turkey (Fairy Chimney houses and an underground city hewn from the rock!) and the rugged and breathtaking natural beauty rivalled only by the deep spirituality of Bhutan.

**Graeme Thomson** co-directed his first tour with **Sue Bunten** on the Seine a Velo and Hidden Normandy tour. Graeme and Sue helped riders experience the thrill of cycling through central Paris and along the Seine River west through cities and villages concluding at the Normandy beaches and the D-Day landing sites.

Steve Saxe had the unique experience of co-directing and then immediately after, directing his first two tours on the Chateaux of the Loire Valley, sections 1 & 2 tours. As director on section 1, **Bridgette**Deshields Martinez inspired the confidence in her co-director Steve to direct section 2 along with Kim Kasabali. Together, Steve, Bridgette and Kim guided riders through this UNESCO World Heritage area. The châteaux, towns and villages, the river and its culture, winegrowing, and gastronomy all fit perfectly into this magnificent landscape, that of Europe's last untamed river.

**Peter Kepfer**, a first-time driver, joined the leadership team for section 2.

Again, thank you first time Ride Leadership team members. And thank you everyone who directed, codirected, coordinated or drove for a BAC tour in 2024. Friends leading friends; that's what it's all about.

### **Foreign Accident Insurance**

The following information was recently shared with ride leaders for input. We are now presenting this to the general membership for feedback / suggestions.

Our foreign accident insurer will increase our annual premium from \$19,813 to \$40,879 on 4/17/2025, based on our claim history. Although we only have one or two claims per year, there was a major claim in 2023 and another in 2024. These required hospitalization in a foreign country followed by emergency repatriation to the US. The data below shows that our insurer has paid out more in claims than we've paid in premiums in the last two years, a reversal from our prior years' experience.

Our options to avoid this are very limited. In the past our agent has shopped for a cheaper insurer. No other insurers were willing to bid at all, let alone at a lower premium. Given our claim history, it's even less likely now that we'd get a better offer from another insurer. It's unlikely that increasing our \$1,000 deductible would make much of a difference, given the size of our claims.

We'd like to make the BAC membership aware and solicit your thoughts. Some options might include:

Cancel BAC insurance and encourage participants to insure themselves. Many already double up and buy their own insurance. However, it's our understanding that leaders value BAC insurance and the emergency assistance service, because it takes worry off of them.

**Increase the overseas ride fee to cover the increase.** At this new premium the estimated cost per overseas rider will be \$76, an increase of \$39. This covers them for as many tours as they take in a year. We would make participants aware that BAC insurance is still a bargain compared to individual policies.

**Increase the ride fee retroactively.** Increasing the fee for new registrants won't help much until 2026 because most fees on 2025 rides are already collected. We may want to make an assessment on 2025 rides to match the premium increase with the participants who will benefit from the insurance.

**Increase the membership renewal fee.** Renewals are currently priced at \$10 less than new memberships. Equalizing them would generate about \$15K/year. This would affect the entire membership, not just those on overseas tours.
