BAC's Annual General Meeting will be held Sunday, February 28, 2021 at 3:30 pm AKST/4:30 pm PST/5:30 pm MST/6:30 pm CST/7:30 pm EST via Zoom. Agenda items will include the receipt of reports highlighting the Club's activities over the past year, approval of the 2020 financial report, approval of an amendment to the bylaws to increase the maximum size of the Board, election of new Directors, and an opportunity for Club members to ask questions and make comments. More details will be provided in the February 2021 Update on how to sign up to participate in the meeting.

BAC BOARD ELECTION 2021

The Board has nominated Marion Campbell and Jan Erickson to additional three year terms and Sue Bunten to a three year term. Biographical information is provided for each of them below. Candidates may also be nominated for election to the Board through petition by 2% of the membership up until January 14, 2021. . You will receive an email January 15, 2021 asking you to log into the BAC website, click on the "We Need Your Vote" link at the top of the page, and indicate how you would like your proxy to be voted at the Annual General Meeting. Proxies will be solicited from January 15 to February 15, 2021 for candidates nominated by the Board and those nominated by the membership. The proxies cast will be exercised by the Board Chair at the Annual General Meeting following the direction provided.

Sue Bunten (Vancouver, BC, Canada) I have been impressed with this club and its members since joining in 2017. After my first trip as a single rider and driver (Yellowstone), I knew it was for me and luckily got the last spot at the fall 2017 Ride Leader Seminar in Davis, CA. Since then I have been co-leader on 2 rides in the US and 3 rides in Europe, and leader on 2 rides (Beaches of S. California 2018 and Selkirk International Loop 2019). I 've also done 3 tours with the Canadian touring club Cross Canada Cycle Tour Society and cycle regularly around Vancouver with a local cycling club.

I am a relatively new member and ride leader so would come to the Board with an open mind and a willingness to work. I support making it easier for others to become ride co leaders and leaders. As reported in the 2018 BAC Membership Survey results, between Jan. 2014 and Dec. 2018 almost half of all new club members were singles. As a single rider myself, I completely understand the difficulty a keen single rider faces in considering leading a trip until without a co leader. I would love to see the club make it easier for single riders to find other single riders with compatible skills to form leadership teams and offer more rides! I am a dual citizen and have served on my condo boards in both Vancouver (2 years) & S. California (4 years) and understand a Directors' obligations to fairness, confidentiality and fiduciary duty. I support a collaborative style, use of committees, and transparency. In my career I worked for 30 years on the British Columbia coast as a federal fisheries officer doing patrols, planning, coordination and file prep often in coordination with various other agencies and dealing with a variety of legal issues.

Marion Campbell (Spring, TX) Marion has been riding bicycle tours (mostly with his wife, Alice) since 2001. The first were with tour companies such as America by Bicycle, Pedal Tours, and Experience Plus. In 2014 he joined BAC and has been committed to their tours since that time. He recognized two major advantages with BAC. First the participants were experienced riders and shared a love for cycling. Second, attracting experienced bike riders meant that the cost of unnecessary support could be avoided. This coupled with the non-profit structure of BAC make these tours the best value for the money! Marion has participated in 8 BAC tours since 2014. Recently he has served as tour reviewer for two upcoming rides and is a member of the Central Review Committee and has been on the board of directors of BAC since January of 2020. He is a chemical engineer by profession and worked in various engineering and operations positions for BASF chemical company for 35 years before retiring. He has served on and held officer positions on several non-profit boards including Junior Achievement, Brazosport Community Foundation, and EPD, a small company dedicated to hiring handicapped employees. Currently he spends time cycling, playing clarinet in bands and orchestras, and participating in mission projects such as a church build in Alaska and water wells in Africa. As a board member he hopes to contribute in establishing policy and guidelines that will keep BAC an exciting and sustainable organization both now and in the future.

Jan Erickson (Winthrop, WA)) I have been a member in good standing with BAC since 2008 and committed to the philosophy of the mission statement; connecting members socially through organized tours, mutual respect for others, and members' independence and self-reliance with the adventure we all expect. It is important to pay forward and pay back. An organization cannot survive without its members' involvement. I consider myself as one who plays well with others and can look at the big picture for a good outcome of ideas. I have been a co-leader on four rides that Jim and I developed and led. Jim and I led three rides and one of our rides with another BAC leader. I am always willing to help other leaders while on rides. I have been on nine domestic and four international BAC ride. Jim and I have done a number of self-contained rides. I taught High School Physical Education for 28 years, and was the Director for a Wellness Program for the Faculty and Staff of over 1200. I have been a presenter and leader for the Tacoma Mountaineers, presenter at the Washington State Track and Field Annual Conference, served as President of my Homeowners Association, and the Events Director (14 events) and Volunteer Coordinator (200 volunteers) and eventually became a Board Member of Methow Trails. I am a good project manager and perfected that work through my positions with Methow Trails. I know what it takes to be a contributing member of a board. I organize well and have good logistical

skills. I am currently serving as a board member and would be honored to continue to serve as member of the Board of Directors.

AMENDMENT TO THE BYLAWS TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE BOARD

BAC's Bylaws were amended in 2019 to increase the maximum size of the Board from seven to nine members. Reasons for the change included a better ability to backfill key positions on the Board (e.g., Treasurer and Chair of the Website Committee); to increase the size of the pool that the Board Chair will come from; to reduce the workload for individual Board members; and to have a more balanced turnover in Board members (three positions will be up for election each year). This change must be approved by the membership. As a result, your proxy approving this change is also being solicited as part of the election process this year.

JANUARY 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

2020 was quite a year! BAC had three tours before COVID-19 resulted in widespread lockdowns across the country and around the world and the closing of international borders. A domestic tour successfully occurred in the fall along with an online version of our ride leader training.

Many thanks to the ride leaders who put in many hours to plan tours for 2020. Unfortunately most had to be rescheduled to 2021 or 2022 or cancelled. It is encouraging to see the number of ride leaders who are starting to contemplate tours in late 2021 or in 2022. Long time ride leader Lucy Glover is currently trying to gauge interest for a September 2021 San Francisco to Santa Barbara tour as are Liz Enright and Jan Gleason, graduates of the 2020 Ride Leader Seminar, for a tour in scenic Door County, Wisconsin in late September 2021. More information and contact details are provided below in this newsletter. If you are interested in either of these tours, please let the ride leaders know as soon as possible.

It is possible that as we move through 2021, some ride leaders may insist that tour participants provide evidence that they have been vaccinated before they can participate. At this time, the Board is of the view that a ride leader has the prerogative to make this a requirement. Nonetheless, the Board is also of the view that it is premature to stipulate this as a requirement for the following reasons:

I Like everything with COVID-19, the situation is evolving rapidly. It is probably best for

Ride Leaders to follow the framework in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines and have a Zoom meeting with participants 45-90 days in advance of the planned tour start to discuss how the tour can safely proceed, recognizing that it is possible for a tour to proceed safely in the absence of a COVID-19 vaccine. No question that the risk is lower if participants have been vaccinated.

Vaccines are expected to be generally available by late spring or early summer. To date, the United States government has purchased 200 million doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine and 200 million doses of Moderna's vaccine, enough for roughly sixty percent of all Americans. President-elect Biden has committed his administration to vaccinating a million Americans a day during the first 100 days of his administration (i.e., by the start of May).
Many will need to wait until late spring or summer before they can be vaccinated.
The CDC recommends that because there is limited information on how well COVD-19 vaccines work in the general population (e.g., how much it may reduce disease, severity, or transmission; and how long protection lasts), vaccinated persons should continue to follow all current guidance (e.g., mask wearing, physical distancing, washing hands often, etc.) to protect themselves and others.

It is not clear if a COVID "passport" will be required for international travel or for boarding an airplane. Currently, several digital vaccine passports are under development but issues around documenting vaccinations and sharing the information securely will need to be addressed before they can be put into widespread use. This could take months if not years. 2021 ONLINE RIDE LEADER SEMINAR

The very well received online Ride Leader Seminar will be reprised in March 2021. Sessions will be held on Mondays and Thursdays, March 8, 11, 15, 18 and 22 from 4:30-6:30 pm PST with homework between sessions. Comments from the November 2020 session included "Overall, this seminar was the best online sessions I've attended"; "You all did an amazing job! I was so impressed by the organization, the use of technology, and the incredible resources available to ride leaders in the website"; "I thought the training was excellent, it held my attention the entire time". PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE RIDE LEADER POLICIES & GUIDELINES

Changes to the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines were approved in principle by the Board at its December 2020 meeting. It was agreed that two additional criteria enabling experienced ride leaders to lead more than four tours in a calendar year should be added, specifically: Inhat occur at "off peak" times of the year (e.g., November to March) and are in areas where BAC tours do not regularly occur, or ² For any other unique set of circumstances accepted by the Board (e.g., tours that had to be rescheduled). MARCH 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

What a difference a year makes! At this time last year we were starting to grapple with COVID19 and what it meant to our planned 2020 tours. Club members who were scheduled for

upcoming trips at that time were encouraged to be patient and as flexible as possible.

We continue to urge those with scheduled trips to be patient and as flexible as possible in

particular for any trip that goes outside the US. A recent article in the Washington Post

(https://www.washingtonpost.com/travel/2021/02/24/travel-safe-covid-when/) suggests that travel between countries could start as early as mid to late 2021. Which countries and when will depend on the vaccination rates, what the local positivity rates are, and an absence of new variants that complicate any kind of intervention. As one of the individuals quoted in the article noted, "I wouldn't book a flight yet."

Travel within the US in 2021 looks far more promising. The expectation is that states with travel restrictions (e.g., California has a ten day quarantine for travellers coming from other states or countries), will relax them as more people get vaccinated. One expert advised "that only people who have been vaccinated or infected with the virus travel this summer".

BAC continues to follow its COVID-19 framework detailed in the Ride Leader Policies & Guidelines which is available on the BAC website under the DOCS tab. At least 45-90 days before any tour is scheduled to start, a decision will be made to see if the required conditions exist for it to proceed. For out-of-country tours, the destination country(ies) must be allowing international tourism. Members should also take note that many of the ride descriptions for tours approved over the past year include under Ride Participant Responsibility the statement "Members should also ensure that vaccinations are up to date (e.g., annual influenza, tetanus, etc.)." As more members become eligible for vaccinations in the jurisdictions they live in, a COVID-19 vaccination will increasingly fall into the category of a vaccination members should have up to date.

Many of our ride leaders are looking forward to getting out on tours with you again. Ten new tours are available for sign up this month—one 2021 tour and nine 2022 tours. It is great to see this level of planned activity! For those who have been hesitant about leading a tour, "deep dive" sessions on the financial aspects of a tour, managing hotel costs and contracts, and everything you ever wanted to know about leading a commercially assisted tour, will be provided over the next few months. More information is provided below.

Annual General Meeting

BAC's Annual General Meeting was held via Zoom on February 28, 2021. While it wasn't the same as meeting in person, it provided members from across the US and beyond an opportunity to participate without having to travel. Participants were positive about the format and

recommended continued usage of it in future to permit participation by a broader range of members. Sue Bunten, Marion Campbell and Jan Erickson were elected to three year terms on the Board and the membership approved the requested change to the bylaws to increase the maximum size of the Board to nine members.

APRIL 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

It's great to see tours happening again and how quickly recently posted tours have been filled! Tours that are based solely in the US are proceeding with protocols in place to reduce the risk of participants contracting Covid-19. Ride leaders will be holding Zoom calls with participants in advance of the tour to discuss the protocols. Based on my interactions with club members over the past month, it seems like a significant number of members have already been vaccinated or are scheduled to be vaccinated. All members are strongly encouraged to get vaccinated before participating in upcoming tours to better protect themselves and other participants on the tour. All tours outside the US up to the end of July 2021 have now been rescheduled or cancelled. No one knows when international borders will open up and travel possible again. Vaccination rates in most other countries at this time are significantly lower than those in the United States. The most recent wave which is being driven by Covid-19 variants is also causing considerable concern. Ride leaders will be in touch with participants well in advance of the planned international tours to discuss the situation and potential options.

The Board held a series of meetings following the Annual General Meeting February 28th. One of the key focuses this coming year will be working with ride leaders and potential ride leaders to given them the tools and assistance they need to successfully plan and lead tours. Glenn Rudolph (Gerudolph@gmail.com) is a key contact for ride leaders as they plan their tours. The Ride Training and Development Committee has just finished providing two Zoom sessions on ride budgeting and accounting and will be offering sessions on managing hotel costs and contracts, and everything you ever wanted to know about leading a commercially assisted tour over the next two months. JUNE 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

It is great to see tours happening again—three domestic tours so far this year with another sixteen scheduled. It is not clear as yet which tours scheduled outside the US will proceed this year. Unfortunately, there is still a lot of uncertainty about the conditions that must exist for travel, especially to other countries.

As noted in the section in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines on COVID-19 and BAC Tours, the Board prioritizes the health and safety of our members and will not put members knowingly at risk while on a tour. Further, as a minimum, the BAC Board will always require that the guidelines/directives of the governments in the regions where tours are to take place and those of participants' home countries are followed.

According to the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), domestic travel should be delayed until you are fully vaccinated. When travelling, a mask should be worn when on any public transit. After travel, you should self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms and isolate and get tested if symptoms develop.

The Board will be hosting a Zoom call with ride leaders on Wednesday, June 2nd to discuss whether ride leaders should have total discretion as to whether vaccinations are required on a tour or whether the Board should mandate it. Exceptions would be provided but a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours before a tour would be required along with mask wearing and social distancing consistent with CDC guidelines for non-vaccinated travelers.

We know that there is not unanimity amongst our membership on this issue. Many have already

taken the steps necessary to become fully vaccinated. Others are quite adamant that they will not participate on any tour where vaccinations are required. Other organizations similar to BAC are also wrestling with this issue. One organization I'm aware of will require all participants on their tours August 1, 2021 or later to be fully vaccinated and to have a copy of their CDC vaccination card or an electronic copy on their phone available at the first meeting. A leader may request a copy of it prior to the start of the tour. Another organization requires participants to be fully vaccinated or to obtain a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours or less before the start of the tour. Policy Updates

At the Board's May 2021 meeting, two changes to the Ride Leader Policies & Guidelines were given final approval.

Mentor/Tour Reviewer responsibilities have been added by replacing the section entitled Tour Review Criteria on page 20 with:

TOUR APPROVAL. All tours shall have an assigned Mentor/Tour Reviewer. As the Ride Leader/Ride Coordinator, you can choose any BAC ride leader in good standing who agrees, to fulfill this role. New ride leaders in particular may want to work with a Mentor before their first tour is submitted. If you don't have anyone in mind for this role, contact the Chair, Ride Management Committee and a Mentor/Tour Reviewer will be assigned.

The Mentor/Tour Reviewer is responsible for:

• Working with new ride leaders as required, providing guidance on how to develop a tour and budget before it is formally reviewed for approval;

• Reviewing ride proposals for compliance against the requirements of the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines. This includes:

- Consistency with BAC Mission and Values.

- Absence of conflict with existing approved rides and rides in areas where other Ride Leaders may have priority.

- Ride Leader experience and qualifications. For example, if someone hasn't participated in the Ride Leader Seminar have they demonstrated experience in organizing bike tours or other events elsewhere?

- Has the Ride Leader complied with BAC policies on prior tours led?

• Communicating to the ride leader the required changes that will bring ride proposals into compliance;

· Advising the Ride Management Director(s) when a tour is ready for Board approval;

· Reviewing and authorizing payment requests from Ride Leaders/Ride Coordinators;

• Addressing questions or concerns Ride Leaders/Ride Coordinators may have in the period leading up to, during or after the ride;

Following completion of the Tour Reviewer's review, the proposed ride is submitted to the full BAC board for review and vote.

Each BAC Board member applies his or her personal judgment when considering a ride for approval. A Board member is under no obligation to vote to approve a ride. A Ride Proposal requires affirmative votes from a minimum of two-thirds of the current Board members for approval (e.g. four affirmative votes if six on the Board, five affirmative votes if seven on the Board, six affirmative votes if nine on the Board).

A change on page 47 was also given final approve to provide greater clarity as to when the final decision on whether an international tour will proceed or not. The following text will be added to the paragraph at the top of the page: "The final decision for proceeding with an international tour should be made and communicated to the participants no later than 90 days prior to the start of the tour in order to give participants adequate time to finalize or cancel travel plans." JULY 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

Many thanks to everyone who provided input last month on the question of whether participants need to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 on tours or not on a going forward basis. Based on the input received, the Board has approved in principle several changes to the Ride Leader Policy and Guidelines (RLPG).

Added to the list of COVID-19 considerations a ride leader must make when planning a tour (page 3): Whether you want all participants on your tour to have been vaccinated for COVID including any booster shots, whether you want your participants to have been tested for COVID at least 72 hours before the tour starts, or whether you will leave it up to your participants to take whatever precautions they believe are necessary (e.g., vaccinated, wear masks when indoors, socially distance, etc.)
Added to the items to be included in the Ride Description (page 17): o COVID Requirements – Ride Leaders should include one of the following three

statements here:

Il participants must be fully vaccinated including booster shots if applicable and be prepared to present vaccination documentation for viewing by Ride Leader if requested1

 Participants should be fully vaccinated including booster shots if applicable and be prepared to present vaccination documentation for viewing by Ride Leader if requested1
 All unvaccinated participants must

comply with safety provisions such as a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours or less before a tour starts, masks and social distancing or alternate precautions as specified by the Ride Leader. 2 Participants will not be required to be vaccinated but all must comply with

safety provisions such as a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours or less

before a tour starts, masks and social distancing or alternate precautions as specified by the Ride Leader.

Tour leaders have the option to accept a verbal or written declaration of vaccine status or of asking to see vaccination certificates of tour participants either in a pre-tour video call or at the start of the tour. However tour leaders must not keep, copy or store vaccination certificates due to the risk of violating privacy laws respecting medical records.

Changes are also being made to the electronic waiver that all members must sign prior to being accepted on any tour so that the paper COVID-19 waiver will no longer be required. This change is expected to be implemented by August 1,

2021. As a result, the following addition has been made (p. 49):

All participants who sign their electronic Ride Waiver on or after August 1, 2021 will also agree to assume the risk that they may be exposed to or infected by an infectious disease, environmental toxins, or other health hazards by participating in a BAC tour and that such

exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. As a result they will no longer need to provide a signed copy of Annex B.

The language associated with the medical coverage on page 19 has also been changed to make it clearer as to what should be used depending on whether the tour is solely in the United States, if it is in the United States and Canada, or if it is totally outside the United States.

An extract of the RLPG showing all of the planned changes is available for download from the BAC website under the DOCS tab. A copy of the revised waiver form is also available. If you have any comments on the planned changes please send them to Marion Campbell (mwcampbell@earthlink.net) by July 15, 2021.

The planned changes to the RLPG will apply to any new tours approved on a going forward basis. For the almost sixty tours that are already scheduled to start July 1, 2021 or later, the ride leaders have been asked to clarify the tour's vaccination requirements using one of the three statements provided above. The chosen statement is to be added to the Ride Leader Comments box at the top of the Ride Description and all participants on the tour are to be contacted advising them of these requirements, ideally by July 15, 2021 or as soon as possible thereafter. Tour participants will have a no penalty "opt-out" period until July 31, 2021 during which time they may withdraw from a tour if they choose due to the COVID-19 requirements and receive a refund of the ride registration and credit card fees. Any additional refund of the tour payments will be determined by the leader in accordance with the cancellation policy as stated in the Ride Description. This might mean that if payments were made that cannot be recovered, the cancelling party might have to absorb their portion.

Frequently Asked Questions

During my time as a Board member, I have come to realize that many of the things I take for granted in how BAC operates are mysteries to many of our members. To try and reduce these mysteries, the Board has developed a series of frequently asked questions that address:

AUGUST 2021 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

Over the next two and a half months, BAC's 2021 season will get into high gear with 11 US based tours. It's been a difficult year for all but our ride leaders have risen to the challenge. Some have had to scramble to find new hotels, restaurants, vehicle rental arrangements, etc. with planned suppliers no longer in business. In one case, the ride leader had to reroute a significant portion of the planned tour because the US/Canada border was closed to nonessential travel. If you were fortunate to get a spot on one of these remaining tours (they are all fully booked), make

sure to thank your ride leader for their efforts.

Planning continues for 2022. There is still space available on a number of tours in both the US and Overseas. Others have been posted this month or will be in the coming months. I know that many of you are looking forward to getting out on tours once again. We look forward to seeing you!

Policy

The Board gave final approval to the changes to the Ride Leader Policy & Guidelines (RLPG) that were described in the July 2021 Update. The approved changes were: Added to the list of COVID-19 considerations a ride leader must make when planning a tour (page 3): Whether you want all participants on your tour to have been vaccinated for COVID including any booster shots, whether you want your participants to have been tested for COVID at least 72 hours before the tour starts, or whether you will leave it up to your participants to take whatever precautions they believe are necessary (e.g., vaccinated, wear masks when indoors, socially distance, etc.) Added to the items to be included in the Ride Description (page 17): o COVID Requirements – Ride Leaders should include one of the following three

statements here:

I All participants must be fully vaccinated including booster shots if applicable and be prepared to present vaccination documentation for viewing by Ride Leader if requested1

Participants should be fully vaccinated including booster shots if
 applicable and be prepared to present vaccination documentation for
 viewing by Ride Leader if requested1
 All unvaccinated participants must
 comply with safety provisions such as a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours
 or less before a tour starts, masks and social distancing or alternate
 precautions as specified by the Ride Leader.
 Participants will not be required to be vaccinated but all must comply with

safety provisions such as a negative COVID-19 test 72 hours or less before a tour starts, masks and social distancing or alternate precautions as specified by the Ride Leader.

Tour leaders have the option to accept a verbal or written declaration of vaccine status or of asking to see vaccination certificates of tour participants either in a pre-tour video call or at the start of the tour. However tour leaders must not keep, copy or store vaccination certificates due to the risk of violating privacy laws respecting medical records.

I Changes were made to the electronic waiver that all members must sign prior to being accepted on any tour so that the paper COVID-19 waiver is no longer be required. This change was implemented by July 8, 2021. As a result, the following addition has been made (p. 49):

All participants who sign their electronic Ride Waiver on or after July 8, 2021 will also agree to assume the risk that they may be exposed to or infected by an infectious disease, environmental toxins, or other health hazards by participating in a BAC tour and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. As a result they will no longer need to provide a signed copy of Annex B.

The language associated with the medical coverage on page 19 has also been changed to make it clearer as to what should be used depending on whether the tour is solely in the United States, if it is in the United States and Canada, or if it is totally outside the United States.

An updated version of the RLPG has been posted to the BAC website (DOCS tab) that includes these changes.

As set out in Section 3.1 of the Bylaws, a Board member must be a club member for at least two years prior to his/her assumption of office, must be a club member throughout his/her tenure as a Board Member, and must be in continued compliance with the bylaws and the Board's governance policies including the Board Members' Code of Conduct during their tenure on the Board.

The club's Board Policies which were most recently updated in March 2021 and available on the BAC website under "Docs" outlines the Board Job Description; the characteristics, qualities and perspectives sought in Board members; the roles of Officers of the corporation; and existing committees and their responsibilities. The Board is specifically looking for someone at this time that has experience as a BAC ride leader and someone who could ultimately take over responsibility for the website from Jim Yuhn.

These proxies will be exercised by the Board Chair at the Annual General Meeting currently scheduled for February 27, 2022. SAVE THE DATE! 2022 On-line Ride Leader Seminar

OVERVIEW: If you want to lead a BAC ride but don't know where to start then plan to

participate in the BAC Zoom Ride Leader Seminar in four two hour sessions in February 2022.

This live web-based training was first offered in November 2020 and received rave reviews.

Most of the training participants have now offered their own rides through BAC.

Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2/8, 2/10, 2/15 and 2/17

Time: 7:30 – 9:30 PM EST (4:30 – 6:30 PST) for each session.

The program will feature:

- On-line classes via Zoom
- Team projects between sessions
- Frequent knowledge checks with quizzes, games, and activities.

Experienced presenters (ride leaders and board members) will provide the tools you need to lead a successful BAC ride in the USA and international locations. We will cover how to lead all types of rides including point-to-point, fixed-based, self-directed, and commercially assisted. You will learn all aspects of leading rides from developing, budgeting and planning, to leading the ride and finalizing all paperwork. Each seminar participant will learn how to access resources needed to propose and manage tours.

Our goal is that participants will master the knowledge and skills needed to successfully propose a ride within 12 months of completing the seminar and to successfully lead the tour.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This seminar is primarily for BAC members who are interested in leading a ride for the first time. It is also helpful for those who have previously led BAC rides and want more training. If seminar registration reaches the maximum number of 30 participants, preference will be given to first-time ride leaders.

Seminar participant responsibility

A successful Seminar depends on participants actively engaging in the program. Participants will need to have: • An up-to date computer with working camera and microphone. The BAC cannot provide tech support but will, as needed, provide links to tutorials on using Zoom before the seminar begins.

• Access to the internet

• A quiet environment to participate in the program – free of distractions (such as pets) Registration will be in Zoom and information about how to register will be coming in a future newsletter.

MEMBERS CORNER

Start 2022 off with a great tour in Spain - White Villages of Andalucia 2022. This excellent ride features the beautiful region of Andalucía in southern Spain, known for its Moorish architecture and history, white hilltop villages, flamenco, oranges, and olive groves. Interest has been picking up and we are getting close to our minimum number of participants. Don't miss your chance to enjoy this tour that has received very high ratings on each of the previous 5 editions (2011, 2012, 2015, 2016, 2018). After being cancelled in 2020 & 2021 due to COVID we will once again be running this tour with the outstanding IberoCycle tour company, for the 2022 version we incorporated an additional day allowing us to shorten one of the longer days and add a visit to the city of Jerez, famous for it's sherry & wine. Spain has one of the highest vaccination rates (80+%) in the world and on my recent visit to Spain in September I found the mask compliance and general COVID safety to be very good. For more details about the tour please see the trip description.

There are still openings in the Vienna Woods and the Austrian Lake District 2022. Currently Austria is 60.8% fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and 64.4% with at least one dose, a higher rate than the USA. This trip has been offered twice before and loops from Baden (near Vienna) to Mondsee (near Salzburg) and back. The trip has received mostly five-star reviews and has been completely scouted with detailed maps, cue sheets, and GPS tracks making it a great adventure while minimizing the frustration of inaccurate information. Participants from the prior trips have made such comments about this trip as: "Best BAC trip I've ever taken (18 to date)"; "Roger & Tony were concerned about everyone's well-being on the trip, very genuine"; "menus and meals beautifully presented"; "the mountains, lakes, fresh air, dramatic landscapes, picture-perfect farms"; "being surprised with a birthday cake at dinner!"; "the quality of the roads made riding an absolute joy"; "attending Mass on Corpus Christi in the Mariazell Basilica; one of the 7 most important pilgrimage cities in Europe"; "the prolific flowers, in yards, along the roads, in overflowing window boxes", "the connection I felt to the country through the routes and the hotel hosts"; "it's harder than I expected, but I love it"; "I'd sign up again in a heartbeat"......and so it went.
