BAC BOARD ELECTION 2022

Proxies will be solicited from January 15 to February 15, 2022 for candidates nominated by the Board and those nominated by the membership. JANUARY 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

I'm optimistic that 2022 will see more BAC tours than we had in 2021 (18 tours in the U.S. occurred in comparison to four tours in 2020). There are currently 19 tours wholly in the U.S., five in whole or in part in Canada, and 26 in Europe, England and Ireland scheduled for 2022. A number of these tours still have space and are worth considering.

Kudos to our ride leaders who have shown considerable flexibility and adapted to the ever changing conditions during 2021. This flexibility and adaptability will undoubtedly continue during 2022. At this point it is impossible to know when the peak will be reached with the Omicron variant although a number of experts believe that there is a good possibility that we could move from a pandemic to an endemic with it.

In recognition of the evolving situation with respect to Covid-19, the Board approved in principle changes to our Covid-19 requirements in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines in December as described below to make it more likely that tours outside the U.S. can proceed.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE RIDE LEADER POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

Changes to the Covid-19 requirements in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines were approved in principle by the Board in late December 2021. The proposed changes are provided in the document entitled *RLPG 20211223 changes approved in principle.pdf* which is available under the Docs tab on the BAC website in the section entitled "For Ride Directors and Coordinators".

Key changes include:

• Making the decision on whether a tour will proceed contingent on whether tourism will be allowed in the country(ies) (or specific regions) where your tour takes place and what

COIVD precautions may be required rather than basing it on the State Department's most recent travel advisory.

- Reducing from three to two, the mandatory statement options that a ride leader must choose from and include with the ride description—either all participants must be fully vaccinated (for participants that are eligible this means being up-to-date on boosters) or all participants are encouraged to be vaccinated but unvaccinated participants will be permitted. This second statement may only be used for tours solely within the U.S.
- All participants of tours outside the U.S. must be vaccinated. Further, they should receive their boosters as soon as they can after becoming eligible.

SAVE THE DATE! 2022 On-line Ride Leader Seminar

OVERVIEW: If you want to lead a BAC ride but don't know where to start then plan to participate in the BAC Zoom Ride Leader Seminar in four two hour sessions in February 2022.

This live web-based training was first offered in November 2020 and received rave reviews. Most of the training participants have now offered their own rides through BAC.

Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2/8, 2/10, 2/15 and 2/17 **Time:** 7:30 – 9:30 PM EST (4:30 – 6:30 PST) for each session.

The program will feature:

- On-line classes via Zoom
- Team projects between sessions
- Frequent knowledge checks with quizzes, games, and activities.

Experienced presenters (ride leaders and board members) will provide the tools you need to lead a successful BAC ride in the USA and international locations. We will cover how to lead all types of rides including point-to-point, fixed-based, self-directed, and commercially assisted. You will learn all aspects of leading rides from developing, budgeting and planning, to leading the ride and finalizing all paperwork. Each seminar participant will learn how to access resources needed to propose and manage tours.

Our goal is that participants will master the knowledge and skills needed to successfully propose a ride within 12 months of completing the seminar and to successfully lead the tour.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This seminar is primarily for BAC members who are interested in leading a ride for the first time. It is also helpful for those who have previously led BAC rides and want more training. If seminar registration reaches the maximum number of 30 participants, preference will be given to first-time ride leaders.

Seminar participant responsibility

A successful Seminar depends on participants actively engaging in the program. Participants will need to have:

- An up-to date computer with working camera and microphone. The BAC cannot provide tech support but will, as needed, provide links to tutorials on using Zoom before the seminar begins.
- Access to the internet
- A quiet environment to participate in the program free of distractions (such as pets)

Registration will be in Zoom and information about how to register will be coming in a future newsletter.

Emily Cletsoway long time BAC member, ride leader and Board Chairman from 1987-1990 passed away at age 93 March 20th 2021. A note from her obituary....Emily lived in San Luis Obispo, CA and was a nurse, pilot, mother, avid quilter, and international cyclist, Emily was always up to something interesting and adventurous and she had colorful stories to prove it.

After being cancelled in 2020 & 2021 due to COVID we will once again be running this tour with the outstanding IberoCycle tour company, for the 2022 version we incorporated an additional day allowing us to shorten one of the longer days and add a visit to the city of Jerez, famous for it's sherry & wine. Spain has one of the highest vaccination rates (80+%) in the world and on my recent visit to Spain in September I found the mask compliance and general COVID safety to be very good. Currently Austria is 60.8% fully vaccinated against Covid-19 and 64.4% with at least one dose, a higher rate than the USA. This trip has been offered twice before and loops from Baden (near Vienna) to Mondsee (near Salzburg) and back. The trip has received mostly five-star reviews and has been completely scouted with detailed maps, cue sheets, and GPS tracks making it a great adventure while minimizing the frustration of inaccurate information. Participants from the prior trips have made such comments about this trip as: "Best BAC trip I've ever taken (18 to date)"; "Roger & Tony were concerned about everyone's well-being on the trip, very genuine"; "menus and meals beautifully presented"; "the mountains, lakes, fresh air, dramatic landscapes, picture-perfect farms"; "being surprised with a birthday cake at dinner!"; "the quality of the roads made riding an absolute joy"; "attending Mass on Corpus Christi in the Mariazell Basilica; one of the 7 most important pilgrimage cities in Europe"; "the prolific flowers, in yards, along the roads, in overflowing window boxes", "the connection I felt to the country through the routes and the hotel hosts"; "it's harder than I expected, but I love it"; "I'd sign up again in a heartbeat"......and so it went. FEBRUARY 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

Almost six years ago I joined the BAC Board of Directors as Treasurer and three years ago, I became the Board Chair. My last duty will be to chair the Annual General Meeting which will be conducted via Zoom on Sunday, February 27, 2022. As a Board member over the years in different organizations, I've strived to make a difference. BAC has been no exception. Major initiatives over the past six years in which I had a key role included:

- Moving BAC's accounting to the cloud from a desk based system better suited for personal finances.
- Writing the requirements that support the collection of ride payments from our members for tours. Special thanks to Stephen Kiel for pushing for information in real time for ride leaders. It resulted in a design that provided the necessary information for ride leaders and the BAC Treasurer to ensure that the funds associated with the tour were properly recorded.
- Membership surveys in 2018 and 2020. The results from both were extremely useful in guiding Board decision making.
- A policy framework detailing the Board's governance and operational processes. It serves as the up-to-date repository for Board decisions and eliminates the need to go back through the minutes to determine what decisions are still in effect.
- A revised framework for allowable expenses for ride leaders that permitted them to claim more for expenses incurred in planning and conducting a directed tour than they had in the past.
- Revamp of the Budget Worksheet and Final Accounting spreadsheet to add more detail and make it easier for ride leaders to handle currency conversions and exceptions to the

norm. Many thanks to Bridgette DeShields, Stephen Kiel and Jim Nystrom for their very helpful suggestions while I went through multiple iterations.

- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) that were added to the BAC website to address policy and procedural areas of potential interest to our members.
- Increasing the role of non-Board members in the ongoing activities of the Club. When I joined the Board, Board members handled the day-to-day accounting which became more significant with the move to credit card payments (a Club member is now assisting the Treasurer with this); worked with ride leaders to ensure tour descriptions meet policy requirements (experienced ride leaders are now handling this); and delivered training to prospective ride leaders (a committee that includes several individuals who had on the job experience delivering professional development is now handling this with assistance from experienced ride leaders). These changes have resulted in a significantly reduced time commitment from Board members. Like our members, we prefer to be out on our bikes rather than sitting in front of our computers!

There is no question that the past two years have been challenging. It has been encouraging to see how many of you have maintained your memberships over this period and are clearly ready to get back out on tours. As well, thankfully our reserves were sufficient to see us through and we were able to take advantage of the IRS Employee Retention Credit so that no staff layoffs were required. We also eliminated Board travel, cancelled insurance policies associated with tours outside the U.S., conducted training via Zoom rather than in-person, and limited website enhancements to save money. On a going forward basis, it is quite possible that at least the Annual General Meeting and some of the training will continue to be conducted via Zoom as it makes it easier for more of our members to participate.

I'd like to thank my fellow Board members for their contribution during my time on the Board, in particular to Marion Campbell who had to take on more when I landed in hospital for five weeks last spring. My doctor is very happy with my progress to date and hopefully I will get a clean bill of health in the fall when my next major test is scheduled. While I'm a little slower than I used to be, I've been back on the bike, in the pool, and out cross-country skiing. Several of you have suggested that an e-bike may be coming sooner rather than later. I don't think I'm ready to make that leap as yet.

I'd also like to recognize Brenda Cole who will be leaving the Board after four years at the Annual General Meeting. Brenda spent one year as the Vice Treasurer, one year as the Treasurer, and two years as the Secretary during her time on the Board. As a long-time BAC member (more than twenty years) and ride leader, Brenda has many BAC friends who would get in touch with her whenever the Board was dealing with something contentious from which we all benefited. I also appreciated her sage advice on actions I was contemplating. Her perspective often caused me to look at things differently.

Finally, I'd like to thank Nancy Bohnett, BAC's long-time Office Manager. Nancy has always been there, ready and willing to help me out in any way, with grace, calmness and good humor.

Policy Changes

Changes to the Covid-19 requirements in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines (RLPG) were given final approval by the Board in January 2022. Key changes include: Key changes include:

- Making the decision on whether a tour will proceed contingent on whether tourism will be allowed in the country(ies) (or specific regions) where your tour takes place and what COIVD precautions may be required rather than basing it on the State Department's most recent travel advisory. Ride leaders will have up until 60 days before a tour is scheduled to start to make a final go/no go decision in those instances where it is expected that conditions may significantly change. Normally this decision is expected to be made 90 days before a tour is scheduled to start.
- Reducing from three to two, the mandatory statement options that a ride leader must choose from and include with the ride description—either all participants must be fully vaccinated (for participants that are eligible this means being up-to-date on boosters) or all participants are encouraged to be vaccinated but unvaccinated participants will be permitted. This second statement may only be used for tours solely within the U.S.
- All participants of tours outside the U.S. must be vaccinated. Further, they should receive their boosters as soon as they can after becoming eligible.

Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2/8, 2/10, 2/15 and 2/17 **Time:** 7:30 – 9:30 PM EST (4:30 – 6:30 PST) for each session.

The program will feature:

- On-line classes via Zoom
- Team projects between sessions
- Frequent knowledge checks with quizzes, games, and activities.

Experienced presenters (ride leaders and board members) will provide the tools you need to lead a successful BAC ride in the USA and international locations. We will cover how to lead all types of rides including point-to-point, fixed-based, self-directed, and commercially assisted. You will learn all aspects of leading rides from developing, budgeting and planning, to leading the ride and finalizing all paperwork. Each seminar participant will learn how to access resources needed to propose and manage tours.

Our goal is that participants will master the knowledge and skills needed to successfully propose a ride within 12 months of completing the seminar and to successfully lead the tour.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This seminar is primarily for BAC members who are interested in leading a ride for the first time. My goal as a board member would be to work cooperatively with the other board members to ensure that BAC maintains its high level of commitment to provide members excellent tours. FEBRUARY 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Elizabeth Buckingham)

Almost six years ago I joined the BAC Board of Directors as Treasurer and three years ago, I became the Board Chair. My last duty will be to chair the Annual General Meeting which will be conducted via Zoom on Sunday, February 27, 2022. As a Board member over the years in different organizations, I've strived to make a difference. BAC has been no exception. Major initiatives over the past six years in which I had a key role included:

- Moving BAC's accounting to the cloud from a desk based system better suited for personal finances.
- Writing the requirements that support the collection of ride payments from our members for tours. Special thanks to Stephen Kiel for pushing for information in real time for ride leaders. It resulted in a design that provided the necessary information for ride leaders and the BAC Treasurer to ensure that the funds associated with the tour were properly recorded.
- Membership surveys in 2018 and 2020. The results from both were extremely useful in guiding Board decision making.
- A policy framework detailing the Board's governance and operational processes. It serves as the up-to-date repository for Board decisions and eliminates the need to go back through the minutes to determine what decisions are still in effect.
- A revised framework for allowable expenses for ride leaders that permitted them to claim more for expenses incurred in planning and conducting a directed tour than they had in the past.
- Revamp of the Budget Worksheet and Final Accounting spreadsheet to add more detail and make it easier for ride leaders to handle currency conversions and exceptions to the

norm. Many thanks to Bridgette DeShields, Stephen Kiel and Jim Nystrom for their very helpful suggestions while I went through multiple iterations.

- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) that were added to the BAC website to address policy and procedural areas of potential interest to our members.
- Increasing the role of non-Board members in the ongoing activities of the Club. When I joined the Board, Board members handled the day-to-day accounting which became more significant with the move to credit card payments (a Club member is now assisting the Treasurer with this); worked with ride leaders to ensure tour descriptions meet policy requirements (experienced ride leaders are now handling this); and delivered training to prospective ride leaders (a committee that includes several individuals who had on the job experience delivering professional development is now handling this with assistance from experienced ride leaders). These changes have resulted in a significantly reduced time commitment from Board members. Like our members, we prefer to be out on our bikes rather than sitting in front of our computers!

There is no question that the past two years have been challenging. It has been encouraging to see how many of you have maintained your memberships over this period and are clearly ready to get back out on tours. As well, thankfully our reserves were sufficient to see us through and we were able to take advantage of the IRS Employee Retention Credit so that no staff layoffs were required. We also eliminated Board travel, cancelled insurance policies associated with tours outside the U.S., conducted training via Zoom rather than in-person, and limited website enhancements to save money. On a going forward basis, it is quite possible that at least the Annual General Meeting and some of the training will continue to be conducted via Zoom as it makes it easier for more of our members to participate.

I'd like to thank my fellow Board members for their contribution during my time on the Board, in particular to Marion Campbell who had to take on more when I landed in hospital for five weeks last spring. My doctor is very happy with my progress to date and hopefully I will get a clean bill of health in the fall when my next major test is scheduled. While I'm a little slower than I used to be, I've been back on the bike, in the pool, and out cross-country skiing. Several of you have suggested that an e-bike may be coming sooner rather than later. I don't think I'm ready to make that leap as yet.

I'd also like to recognize Brenda Cole who will be leaving the Board after four years at the Annual General Meeting. Brenda spent one year as the Vice Treasurer, one year as the Treasurer, and two years as the Secretary during her time on the Board. As a long-time BAC member (more than twenty years) and ride leader, Brenda has many BAC friends who would get in touch with her whenever the Board was dealing with something contentious from which we all benefited. I also appreciated her sage advice on actions I was contemplating. Her perspective often caused me to look at things differently.

Finally, I'd like to thank Nancy Bohnett, BAC's long-time Office Manager. Nancy has always been there, ready and willing to help me out in any way, with grace, calmness and good humor.

Policy Changes

Changes to the Covid-19 requirements in the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines (RLPG) were given final approval by the Board in January 2022. Key changes include: Key changes include:

- Making the decision on whether a tour will proceed contingent on whether tourism will be allowed in the country(ies) (or specific regions) where your tour takes place and what COIVD precautions may be required rather than basing it on the State Department's most recent travel advisory. Ride leaders will have up until 60 days before a tour is scheduled to start to make a final go/no go decision in those instances where it is expected that conditions may significantly change. Normally this decision is expected to be made 90 days before a tour is scheduled to start.
- Reducing from three to two, the mandatory statement options that a ride leader must choose from and include with the ride description—either all participants must be fully vaccinated (for participants that are eligible this means being up-to-date on boosters) or all participants are encouraged to be vaccinated but unvaccinated participants will be permitted. This second statement may only be used for tours solely within the U.S.
- All participants of tours outside the U.S. must be vaccinated. Further, they should receive their boosters as soon as they can after becoming eligible.

Dates: Tuesdays and Thursdays, 2/8, 2/10, 2/15 and 2/17 **Time:** 7:30 – 9:30 PM EST (4:30 – 6:30 PST) for each session.

The program will feature:

- On-line classes via Zoom
- Team projects between sessions
- Frequent knowledge checks with quizzes, games, and activities.

Experienced presenters (ride leaders and board members) will provide the tools you need to lead a successful BAC ride in the USA and international locations. We will cover how to lead all types of rides including point-to-point, fixed-based, self-directed, and commercially assisted. You will learn all aspects of leading rides from developing, budgeting and planning, to leading the ride and finalizing all paperwork. Each seminar participant will learn how to access resources needed to propose and manage tours.

Our goal is that participants will master the knowledge and skills needed to successfully propose a ride within 12 months of completing the seminar and to successfully lead the tour.

Roxan Kraft - Ride Across Spain (Tarifa to Madrid & Madrid to San San Sebastián)

I joined BAC in 2018 when I did Sardinia-Medieval Towns. I loved the experience and way in which the BAC trips are run. Since then I've done another 5 rides, most of which have been international. Prior to riding with BAC, I've done 12 other international bike tours focused in France, Switzerland and Italy. I retired in 2019 and my passion is traveling on my bicycle, spending time with friends (new & old) and sampling food and wine from around the world. Ride Across Spain was last done in 2017 by Karen Hass. This trip is a repeat with a few slight modifications as a result of learnings from that trip and will utilized IberoCycles as the commercial support. Please join me!

PAYMENT PROCESSING FEE (Ernie Coose)

Payment Processing Fee increasing to 3.7%, effective April 15

Over the last few years credit card companies have been steadily increasing the interchange fees they charge us for processing your payments. One of the main drivers has been the popularity of cash back and rewards cards.

In 2021, we paid 3.7% on average. This is substantially more than the 3% Payment Processing fee we currently deduct from member payments. BAC has been absorbing the difference, but that amount has become significant enough to require a change.

Effective 4/15, we'll be increasing the payment processing fee to 3.7% to fully recover our costs.

For new rides, this rate will be included in estimated cost. The impact will be an extra \$7 in PP fee for each \$1,000 in ride cost.

For existing rides, the new rate will be applied to your final deposit if you pay after 4/15. Paying after 4/15 will not change the amount you pay. It will reduce the amount of your payment that's available to the ride leader to cover costs. This will affect the amount that the group as a whole is refunded post-tour. There will be no difference in refunds between participants on the same ride. We recommend that you pay your final deposit based on the ride leader's due date as you normally would.

SUMMARY OF BAC INSURANCE COVERAGE (Ernie Coose)

BAC maintains insurance that covers participants on foreign and domestic tours. Following is a summary. Insurance policies are posted on the BAC website under Docs/For Ride Directors and Coordinators/Insurance.

Before participating in any BAC tour, members should review their own medical coverage and assess whether to purchase additional travel insurance.

Foreign Accident Insurance (reinstated 4/21/2022)

- Covered Costs
 - Accident and Medical Emergency
 - Costs to treat accidental injuries as well as sudden and unexpected sickness
 - Accidental Death & Dismemberment
 - Evacuation
 - Repatriation of Remains
 - Emergency Family Reunion/Escort
- Coverage Period
 - Door-to-door from home
 - \circ The tour itself plus up to 7 days before and after
 - No more than 90 days total (This used to be limited to 45 days.)
- Covered Persons
 - All tour participants, including citizens of the US and other countries
- Covid in Particular
 - Onset of Covid would be considered a sudden and expected sickness, so treatment costs would be covered.
 - Quarantine costs for a person who is infected or exposed would not be covered.

Domestic Accident Insurance

Domestic coverage is much narrower than foreign, under the assumption that participants will be able to rely on their personal insurance.

- Covered Costs
 - o Accidental Medical and Dental
 - Costs to treat accidental injury.
 - Note that coverage amounts are limited and there's a deductible.
 - Accidental Death & Dismemberment
 - No coverage to treat illness, including Covid.
- Covered Persons
 - o All tour participants, including citizens of the US and other countries

Foreign Liability Insurance (reinstated 4/21/2022) and Domestic Liability Insurance

Both foreign and domestic policies cover damage caused by a participant, including:

- Bodily Injury and Property Damage
- Damage to Rented Premises
- Damage caused by Hired & Non-Owned Autos

Foreign insurance also covers:

- Medical and travel assistance from Travel Guard
- Kidnap & Ransom

MAY 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Marion Campbell)

Spring has sprung and so have BAC tours. Both domestic and international 2022 tours have started. What a welcomed change from the past two years!

Thanks to the hard work of ride leaders, tour reviewers/mentors, Glenn Rudolph and the board, a record 13 new tours were added in March. So, if you are looking for a great vacation getaway check out the many available tours with space available that are now being offered.

Policy Changes

At the April board of directors meeting two policy changes were approved in principle:

- Item #3 on page 22 of BAC governance policy was revised to clarify how to handle conflict of interest issues.
 - Board members must avoid any conflict of interest, or the appearance of a conflict of interest, with respect to their responsibilities to the organization.
- a) Real, or potential, conflicts of interest should be declared by a potentially conflicted Board member or may be raised by any other board member. When a conflict is questionable, a majority vote of the Board, not including the potentially conflicted member(s), will determine if a Board member has a conflict of interest or not. If a conflict exists, the Board member must recuse him or herself from any Board decision making about the matter. The conflicted Board member, with the consent of a majority of the board may be allowed to participate in preliminary discussions of the issues in conflict prior to any motion being made and/or discussed.
 - i) Real or perceived conflicts of interest will be assumed to exist in any decision making associated with a tour where the Board member is part of the leadership team for the tour.
 - ii) Real or perceived conflicts of interest will be assumed to exist in any decision making associated with a personnel evaluation or action where the Board member is the spouse or partner of the employee or contractor.

The identification of any real or perceived conflicts of interest that were not identified on a timely basis may be sufficient grounds to terminate a Board member's, or former Board member's, membership in the Club

- Commercial Tour Contract (RLPG p.13) was revised to say that all commercial tour contracts MUST include the items in Appendix B of the RLPG.
 - See Appendix B for a template agreement that must be used with commercial tour companies. While INDEMNIFICATION and INSURANCE are overseen by

BAC, it is important that they be included in contracts between ride leaders and the tour company.

JUNE 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Marion Campbell)

Over the past few months BAC has had several international tours going. On some of our tours there have been some participants that tested positive for COVID, which resulted in a delay in their return to the U.S. While all tours had COVID protocols in place, there were a few things that were learned that everyone should know concerning COVID and international travel. Bridgette DeShields, our Health and Safety committee chair, and Barb Rudolph, board member in charge of member relations, have put together the following information: If you are on an international trip and exhibit symptoms or have been exposed to COVID:

• Take a self-rapid test. If positive, immediately take another test where you can get "official" results - clinic/testing center/video proctored test. Then see a doctor. Take their recommendations on how to get the recovery certificate/letter in that country. You will need to supply the recovery certificate or a negative test result to your airline to return to the U.S.

• Then wait at least 5 days after symptoms start, take another rapid self-test. If you test negative, you don't need anything else. You should continue to test negative and should be able to use that to get back to the US. If not, you will need to wait until the doctor will issue something saying you have "recovered" - this varies by country.

The US is the only western country requiring testing for re-entry and under a LOT of pressure to drop it for vaccinated people. Hopefully this will happen soon.

Policy Update

At the June 16, 2022, board meeting revisions to two policies were given final approval:

BAC Governance polices (page 21) were revised to clarify procedures to deal with conflict of interest.

Board members must avoid any conflict of interest, or the appearance of a conflict of interest, with respect to their responsibilities to the organization.

a) Real, or potential, conflicts of interest should be declared by a potentially conflicted Board member or may be raised by any other board member. When a conflict is questionable, a majority vote of the Board, not including the potentially conflicted member(s), will determine if a Board member has a conflict of interest or not. If a conflict exists, the Board member must recuse him or herself from any Board decision making about the matter. The conflicted Board member, with the consent of a majority of the board may be allowed to participate in preliminary discussions of the issues in conflict prior to any motion being made and/or discussed.

i) Real or perceived conflicts of interest will be assumed to exist in any decision making associated with a tour where the Board member is part of the leadership team for the tour.ii) Real or perceived conflicts of interest will be assumed to exist in any decision making associated with a personnel evaluation or action where the Board member is the spouse or partner of the employee or contractor.

b) The identification of any real or perceived conflicts of interest that were not identified on a timely basis may be sufficient grounds to terminate a Board member's, or former Board member's, membership in the Club.

The BAC RLPG (Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines) were revised to require specific language requiring specific language in a CAT (commercially assisted tours) contract. Also added was a clearer description/definition of an Orphaned Tour.

Orphaned Tour

An Orphaned Tour is one that

a) has not been offered to the BAC membership in the past three years and is not on the Tours in Planning (TIP) list to occur within the next 18 months

or

b) was led most recently by a ride leader who is no longer a club member

or

c) the most recent ride leader chose to "orphan" the tour

Even for tours that haven't been offered for three years and are not in the TIP, the most recent tour leader, if still a BAC member, should be contacted to determine their intentions regarding the tour.

Commercial tours can only be restricted if the ride coordinator has customized the tour for BAC in conjunction with the tour company. A tour will be considered customized if significant modifications have been made to routes, number of days, or planned special activities. A customized tour will be treated as a directed tour with respect to the "orphaned" tour procedure. The Board may provide flexibility on this if there are extenuating circumstances (e.g., impact of Covid-19 on tours).

CAT Tour Contract Requirements

14. See Appendix B for a template agreement that must be used with commercial tour companies. While INDEMNIFICATION and INSURANCE are overseen by BAC, it is important that they be included in contracts between ride leaders and the tour company.

BAC provides detailed guidance to assist ride leaders in all aspects of planning, announcing, and managing a bike tour. The guidance document, Ride Leader Policies & Guidelines (RLPG), is regularly updated to reflect changing conditions (such as Covid-19) or to improve ride planning and communication.

OCTOBER 2022 VIEW FROM THE CHAIR (Marion Campbell)

I have just reviewed the number of BAC rides that have been completed in the past three years. In 2020 only 4 tours were able to be done due to the event of COVID. In 2021 the number increased to 18 with no international rides. Due to the tenacity of our club members and tour leaders in 2022, 18 domestic and 18 international tours have been completed. An additional 6 domestic and 3 international tours are scheduled to be run before the end of the year bringing the total for 2022 to **45**.

Bridgette DeShields, chair of the health and safety committee recently wrote, "We are at the stage where we need to accept, we can only do so much to manage COVID, but there are things we can do to limit spread. And it doesn't need to have a significant negative impact on the tour." Ms. DeShields also offered the following tips:

- Conduct a self-wellness check each day. Do you have any symptoms, even mild symptoms that could be allergies or the common cold?
- If in doubt, take a test! Continue testing at least every other day and wear a mask around others until symptoms subside. This keeps everyone safe.
- Communicate with the ride leader so they can help manage exposure and give you helpful advice. If you have a roommate, be sure to let them know what is going on.

Tom and Julie Leever recently sent out the following communications to their upcoming 'Adirondacks Fall Foliage 2022' tour. This advice should be considered for all BAC tours. We have been hearing about COVID spread in a number of BAC tours recently. Our personal experience leading six tours in the last year (half in the US and half in Italy) has been one single case on one tour. However, others have experienced a spread of up to half of the participants or higher.

So, what should we all do? The first critical step should be that everyone should be vaccinated and boosted. The second is that if you have any illness before the tour, however mild, you should test yourself and don't come if you test positive. Beyond those steps, practice safe traveling by wearing approved masks whenever you are forced into a compromising situation (i.e., crowded indoor spaces) such as airport transportation shuttles, loading, etc. Sitting in your plane seat should be safe enough, but mask to get on and off. Reconsider taking side trips, but if you do, exercise extreme caution.

On the tour, should you catch COVID, expect to isolate. If possible, you will be able to continue to ride, but if spread develops or your symptoms are more severe, you may have to remain behind or find alternative transportation. We'll assist to the extent that it is safe for the other participants, but only if that's possible. Consider what you need to do and have a contingency plan in advance.

We will be bringing enough test kits to test everyone, but you should also bring some. If you get COVID, you will be testing every other day to determine when you can discontinue your isolation.

Tom & Julie - Stay safe!

I urge each of you to stay safe and be patient with the inconveniences that COVID is now creating on our rides.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OCT 2022
