New Ride Leaders Hilary & Jeff Warner Show Grit

As a BAC Board Member I get to review post tour surveys and each year there are one or two tours that just 'stand out'. Hilary & Jeff' Warner's August "A Gravel Adventure in Northern Vermont" totally wowed me. They pulled off the near almost impossible - a near five star sweep in post tour reviews (but for one dusty hotel) on their first tour as new BAC ride leaders. Not only that, but they did it watching waves of wildfire smoke get swept into Vermont from Canada's massive forest fires before the tour and affecting air quality almost right up to tour start. Smoke – then floods: a 100 year catastrophic floodingcaused a State of Emergency to be declared four weeks prior to tour start. Gone was a key bridge, a key rail trail route - roads washed out , mudslides everywhere.

Jeff had to research road repairs status, locate work-arounds, then re-route, re-scout and finally re-map routes for nearly every day of their tour and he had to do it quickly.

To their great surprise....with the exception of a participant injured in a cycling crash, nobody cancelled, not even as re-routed rides got unavoidably steeper longer and tougher and despite the smoke and changeable air quality and floods and washouts and mudslides.

They both were astonished by the group's level of adventurousness and their willingness to do the tough rides and distances. The tenacity of the group demonstrated what Jeff describes as a key trait common to gravel riders : Flexibility . "When riding gravel you never know what you are going to encounter. You might encounter a day where the grader has just been ahead of you so the road is loose and deep – or it's going to rain and be muddy – so you have to be flexible. Everyone riding on gravel is used to adjustments within the day ". Flexibility & adjustments aplentyyet everybody adored this tour and their leaders. They all showed grit...and want more gravel. Having recently been elected to serve as the Board Chairman, I (Barb Rudolph) am honored to work side by side with a fantastic team committed to BAC's mission.

The BAC Board met in person in San Diego, CA for their annual board retreat. It was very nice for everyone on the Board to meet each other in person.

At the annual retreat the Board:

- Reviewed key accomplishments of 2023
- Identified key business risks and options for minimizing and mitigating
- Identified priorities for the coming year
- Approved a budget for the coming year consistent with its priorities
- Provided a general orientation on Board member responsibilities and Board governance processes
- Reviewed the Board Member's Code of Conduct

Data presented at the Board Retreat showed the following areas of focus:

- Increase the number of quality rides offered.

POLICY UPDATE

The board approved an update to the Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines (RLPG) for BAC rides beginning in 2025 or later. The RLPG is regularly updated to support consistency in management of BAC rides. Additionally, in 2023 a committee of interested ride leaders made recommendations to the board regarding proposed changes to the RLPG. The updated RLPG is available on the "Docs" page of the BAC website.

BAC Ride Fee

Increases in US insurance premiums have made it necessary to increase our domestic ride fee to cover costs. Effective April 1 the fee will increase from \$50 to \$85. Members who pay their initial deposit on a North America ride on April 1 or later will be charged the \$85 ride fee. The ride fee on Overseas tours will remain \$100.

The most significant premium increase has been in US liability insurance that protects ride leaders, ride participants, and board members. BAC also maintains accident insurance for participants and cyber insurance that protects our system. Coverage applies in the US and overseas.

PAY SOLO SUPPLEMENTS BY ZELLE

BAC is now able to receive solo supplement payments via the Zelle payment transfer system. Checks can still be sent to the BAC office, but members are welcome to use Zelle if it's more convenient and if your bank supports it.

Note: **ONLY** solo supplement payments may be paid via Zelle. All other payments must be paid by credit card through the BAC website, so they can be applied to your account and your ride.

To pay your solo supplement using Zelle:

- In your bank's website, add Bicycle Adventure Club as a new recipient, with email address treasurer@bicycleadventureclub.org
- Initiate a payment
- In the Message block, enter the name of your ride.

Policy Updates: The Board regularly reviews policies in response to suggestions or questions from ride leaders. At the June board meeting we discussed a) should a Ride Co-leader be authorized to make disbursements, b) qualifications for all new (first-time) Ride Directors prior to leading a tour, c) whether there should be similar qualifications for Co-leaders or Drivers, and d) review of qualifications to be a Ride Coordinator of a CAT.

After much discussion, the Board unanimously decided:

- a) Disbursement of payments should remain the sole responsibility of the Ride Director
- all new Ride Directors must have completed RLS or equivalent subject to the approval of the Chair(s) of the Ride Leader Training and Development Committee - in the prior five years.
- c) there should be no additional requirements for Co-leaders or Drivers.
- d) BAC Ride Coordinators must have: 1) Participated as a rider in at least one BAC Directed Tour and one BAC CAT tour; 2) Completed RLS within the last 5 years; and 3)
 Viewed all BAC CAT training materials (on-line video and CAT tour reviewer checklist)

CALL FOR BAC BOARD NOMINATIONS

Nominations to the BAC 2025 Board of Directors are being accepted through October 31, 2024. One vacancy needs to be filled – Tom Leever's second term is coming to an end. In addition, Barb Rudolph and Kate Faulkner will be up for re-election for a second term (three additional years). The term of office for any new Board members will be three years. As set out in Section 3.1 of the Bylaws, a Board member must be a club member for at least two years prior to his/her assumption of office and must be a club member throughout his/her tenure as a Board Member.

The club's Board Policies are available on the BAC website under "Docs", (Board Governance Policies). They outline the Board Job Description; the characteristics, qualities and perspectives sought in Board members; the roles of Officers of the corporation; and existing committees and their responsibilities.

Desirable skills include:

- Commitment to BAC's mission and philosophy
- Ability to work with others
- Project management experience
- Financial management expertise (e.g., accounting, budgeting)
- Marketing/communication skills

If you are interested in serving on the Board, please contact the office (office@bicycleadventureclub.org or 858-715-9510) to determine what information needs to be submitted to support the Nominating Committee's decision-making process.

By the end of November, the Board will determine which candidates it will nominate for election to the Board. The number of nominees will equal the number of positions the Board plans to fill. These nominees will be announced to the membership in the December 2023 Monthly Update. If there are any other members who wish to be nominated directly by the membership, they will have until January 14, 2025, to submit a petition with the signatures of two percent of the membership (approximately 35 signatures). Between January 2, 2025, and February 2, 2025 proxies will be sought for all the nominated candidates. These proxies will be exercised by the Board Chair at the Annual General Meeting.

New Savings on Credit Card Fees

TO DO OR NOT TO DO: Filling out the Ride Survey after a Tour

I had participated in several BAC trips before I led my first trip as a ride leader.

Of course, there was a certain level of nervousness involved as Day 1 of my tour approached, especially when one of my hotels called me two days before hand to let me know my reservations had been cancelled. 🙁 As the tour progressed I tried to get a sense of how the ride

participants were doing. Were they enjoying the riding? The hotels? The scenery? The happy hours? After the tour was over, I reminded everyone that the time window was open to fill out the Ride Survey and then crossed my fingers hoping that they would respond.

As you may recall, there are 11 or 12 items to provide a numerical rating on, depending on the type of tour.

There is also a chance to fill in an open text box with your comments. Any commendations or concerns can be included there.

As you may not know, your ratings and comments are anonymous.

Also, for couples who complete the same tour, it's important that both also complete the ride survey separately.

About 60 days after the tour ended, I had a debrief conversation with Glenn Rudolph who monitors the Ride Survey results. We reviewed how things went including any issues or positive things that occurred. We also discussed a summary of the comments, not the actual comments as submitted by the ride participants. Again, these are confidential.

I found the information from the tour participant's point of view to be extremely valuable in planning my future tours.... regarding both what went well and what could be improved. BAC strives to have each tour be a fun adventure (sometimes with the emphasis on adventure!) and your feedback on the Ride Survey is so helpful for that to happen. I'd like to thank you in advance for taking the time to do this.

UPDATED RLPG (Ride Leader Policy and Guidelines 2025)

The BAC Board has finalized the "Ride Leader Policies and Guidelines for rides beginning in 2025 or later (RLPG 2025). The RLPG 2025 was "approved in principle" and posted to the BAC website in January 2024. The Board took comments on the document and made additional updates and clarifications. Additionally, the Budget Worksheet and Final Accounting (BWFA) was recently updated. The RLPG 2025 includes instructions and graphics for the updated BWFA

This final RLPG 2025 has blue-colored text for changes since the prior-approved RLPG July 2023. RLPG 2025 has been posted to the BAC website Ride Leader Policy & Guidelines 2025

RIDE LEADER SEMINAR

Sign Up Now to Learn How to Become a BAC Ride Leader Four-Part Online Ride Leader Seminar to be Offered in February

If you've ever wanted to become one of the "Friends Leading Friends on Rides," which is the motto of the BAC, then sign up now for the 2025 Online Ride Leader Seminar. The Zoom-based seminar begins February 4 and was developed by the Ride Leader Training and Development Committee to make it easy to learn how to be a BAC ride leader. It consists of four, 2.5 hour online sessions that cover all of the support the BAC provides for its ride leaders. The training is only offered once every year or two so sign up now if you'd like to connect BAC members socially by offering a member-led, quality, affordable bicycle tour.

The seminar will be held from 7-9:30 PM EST (4-6:30 PM PST) on: Tuesday, February 4 Thursday, February 6 Tuesday, February 11 Thursday, February 13

The seminar features:

- On-line classes via Zoom
- Frequent knowledge checks with quizzes and activities
- Between training sessions, there will be projects to complete that are specific to planning a tour you want to lead

Experienced presenters (ride leaders and board members) will provide the tools you need to lead a successful BAC ride in the USA and international locations. We will cover how to lead all types of rides including roaming, semi-roaming, and fixed base. You will learn all aspects of leading rides from developing, budgeting and planning, to leading the ride and finalizing all paperwork. Each seminar participant will learn how to access the BAC resources needed to propose and manage tours.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: This seminar is for BAC members who are interested in leading a ride for the first time. It is also helpful for those who have previously led BAC rides and want more training. To attend, you must be a BAC member and have participated in at least one BAC tour by the day of the first training session.

As soon as your payment has been processed, your name(s) will be added to the Participant List. To contact the Ride Director, click the name at the top of the page. A link will be sent with instructions on how to access the Seminar prior to the first session. The \$50 ride registration fee will be reimbursed for participants who complete all four training sessions.
