Guidelines for Tripper Reports

Thank you for volunteering to write the Tripper report! This report is simply your summary of the ride that you just took. Your objective is to tell other folks about the ride, much as you might describe it to a friend who was not there. Write about the geography in general, how the days unfolded, what you saw along the way, what surprises you encountered, or whatever else would give your readers a sense of your experiences.

There are a few technical wrinkles:

- 1. The report should be roughly a page, and no longer than 600 words (the website imposes this limit). Microsoft Word (Tools/Word Count) can give you a word count.
- 2. Don't list the participants, for the website does that automatically.
- 3. Bold, underlining and italics are not recognized by the website.
- 4. The final report on the website should include a photo. This photo may be submitted separately, perhaps by someone else.
- 5. Please send your report (normally in .doc format), and the photo (always in .jpg format), to the BAC office (office@bicycleadventureclub.org), who will load them onto the website.
